We would like to make you aware that we have enhanced our teams at Regency Nursing Home.

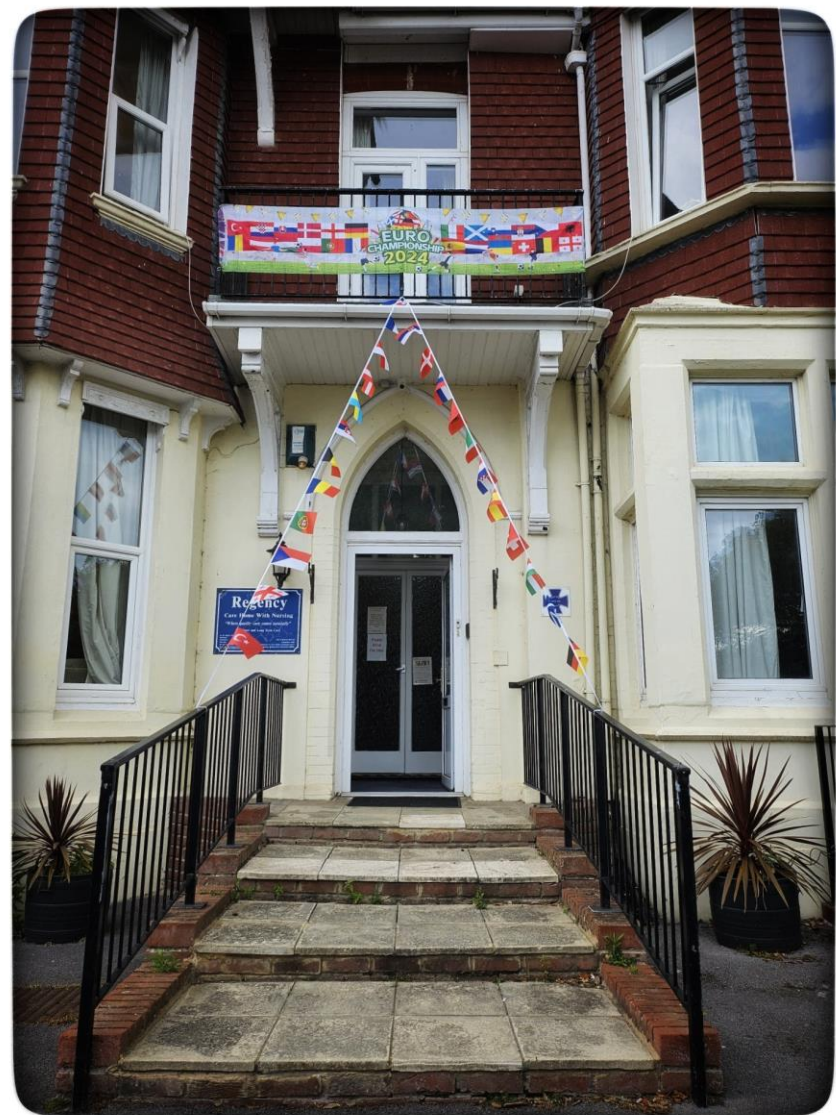
Following discussion with our staff and feedback from external auditors, we now have a new role within the Home.
