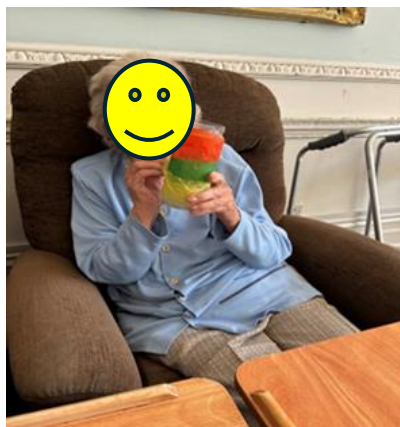
Welcome

In September we enjoyed more indoor activities, as the sunny weather was less reliable. We made our Autumn lanterns, and these were a great success.



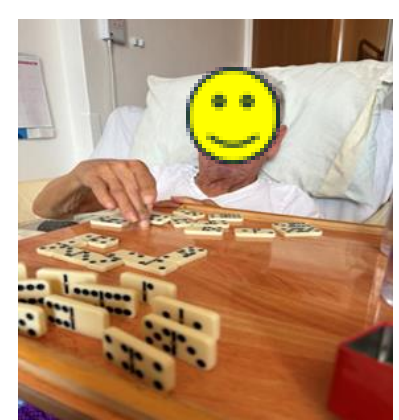
